

Ethics and good practices declaration

For this journal, it is important to maintain high ethical standards in the publication of all its numbers and volumes, reason why it takes the necessary measures to avoid fraud, plagiarism and bad practices.

All authors must submit original and unpublished writings in Spanish, English or Portuguese that belong to the field of physicochemical and related sciences, declaring said characteristics when submitting their works for consideration to the editorial committee.

Confidentiality

Likewise, FUENTES journal seeks to ensure a fair and objective revision of the manuscripts applying blind peer review. The editor and all the editorial staff must not reveal any type of information regarding the manuscripts submitted to the journal for revision. The only ones who can exchange information will be the own author, reviewers, editorial consultants, members of the editorial and scientific committee when necessary.

Originality of articles

FUENTES journal asks authors to present a letter of originality as a requirement and no simultaneous application in other journals or editorial bodies.

Divulagation and conflict of interest

The unpublished material submitted by the author to the journal, must not be used in the editor's researches without the consent of the author himself.

Declaration of good editorial practices and ethical standards

Editor Responsibilities

The editor must act in a balanced, objective and fair manner without any type of sexual, religious or political discrimination, making correct use of the norms established in the Political Constitution of Colombia in this aspect.

Likewise, he must consider editing and publishing the academic contributions for their academic merits without taking into account any type of commercial influence or conflict of interest.

The editor of the journal and the Editorial committee are the responsible of deciding which articles must be published. The editor must follow the policies of the editorial and scientific committees and must take into account the different legal aspects in force concerning issues of defamation, copyright or plagiarism.

In the same way, editors must accept and follow the appropriate procedures to solve possible complaints or misunderstandings of an ethical or conflict of interest nature. The editor and editorial committee will perform in accordance with the regulations, policies and procedures established by Universidad Industrial de Santander. In any case, authors will be given the opportunity to respond to possible conflicts of interest. Any kind of complaint must be supported with documentation and evidence that prove the unsuitable behavior.

Reviewers' responsibilities

Reviewers must contribute objectively to the evaluation process of the articles submitted for consideration in the journal, timely collaborating with the improvement in the scientific quality of these original research products.

Maintain the confidentiality of the data provided by the editor, the editorial committee or the authors, making correct use of the said information by the means provided. However, it is your decision to keep or reject the writing in the evaluation process.

Inform the editor and the editorial committee when the content of an academic contribution presents elements of plagiarism or substantially resembles to other research products published or in the process of publication.

Any arbiter who feels unqualified to review any article or is aware that it will be impossible for him to comply with the haste required to issue his judgment, will justify his excuse of the review process by notifying the editor as soon as possible.

Authors' responsibilities

Authors must acknowledge the article has not been published nor has it been considered for publication elsewhere; besides, the article does not infringe copyright or any other property right of any person or entity and does not contain abusive statements, defamatory, obscene or fraudulent, or any other statement that is illegal in any way.

Keep evidence and accurate records of the data and data analysis related to the manuscript submitted for consideration for the journal FUENTES. When the editor and editorial committee of the journal require this information, authors must supply and ease its access. By the time they are required, the original data will enter to chain of custody that ensures the confidentiality and protection of information by the journal.

Confirm through a publication release form and declaration of conflict of interest act, or by proof of originality (format pre-established by the journal FUENTES) that you agree to submit your article for evaluation by the different committees of the journal. Moreover, authors must state their article is original, unpublished and is not considered or submitted for evaluation and / or accepted in another publication.

When part of the content of this contribution has been published or presented in other means of dissemination, the authors must recognize and cite the respective sources and academic credits.

Declare any possible conflict of interest that may provide an unsuitable influence at any time during the publication process.

Carefully review the final version of the article, prior to publication in the FUENTES journal, informing any errors that may arise and should be corrected. In case of finding significant errors, once the academic contribution has been published, the authors should notify the editor and the editorial committee in a timely manner, subsequently cooperating with the journal in the publication of an erratum, appendix, notice, correction, or in the cases where it is considered necessary to withdraw the writing of the published number.
