

PUBLISHING CRITERIA

Journal *Revista Filosofía UIS* is a biannual publication of the Escuela de Filosofía of the Universidad Industrial de Santander, specialized in philosophical subjects, dedicated to the dissemination of original works, advances and research results in this area.

Authors interested in publishing in the journal should send their texts to our OJS: <http://revistas.uis.edu.co/index.php/revistafilosofiauis/about/submissions>.

Contributions must meet the following requirements:

Publishable texts

Only unpublished articles are accepted. They should be presented exclusively to our journal, and they should deal with a topic in any of the areas belonging to the domain of the journal *Revista Filosofía UIS*, specifically in philosophy, literary theory, political science and aesthetics.

In addition, the author should indicate the category of texts being presented. The possible categories follow Colciencias guidelines for scientific journals. These categories are:

Articles

- **Scientific research articles:** these texts should have an introduction, a methodology, results and conclusions.

- **Reflection articles derived from research:** Academic essays which present research results from an analytical, interpretative or critical perspective on a specific topic and by using of original sources.

- **Review articles:** articles which analyze or systematize research results on a specific scientific problem and field. These texts should have a bibliographical review of at least fifty (50) references that account for advances and development trends).

The length of the articles should be between 5000 and 10000 words. However, Editorial Board will analyze each exceptional case.

Reviews

We publish reviews in Spanish, English and Italian. They must not be longer than 3000 words.

Translations

We publish translations only from texts originally written in another language to Spanish. It is important to know that texts may have copyrights restrictions. Please, be sure that you can publish your translation without any authorization. Otherwise, please seek proper and necessary authorization by yourself.

We recommend texts not to be longer than 10000 words. Editorial Board will analyze elaborately any exceptional case.

ABOUT AUTHORS

Authors may be Professors (Preferably with doctoral studies) Also, graduate students from national or international institutions may publish in our journal. Authors must have a Google Scholar and ORCID profile created and updated.

With the submission of the text, the author must send filled, firm and scanned the *Application letter*. The author expressly informs that this work is not pending of any other process of evaluation or publication. Also, the author must indicate that the text will not be sent in the future to any other Journal or institution for publication unless the Journal *Revista Filosofía UIS* decides not to publish it. Likewise, the author must expressly state that the work respects the norms of copyright and that there is no plagiarism in it.

The personal information about authors (full name, highest academic degree, organizational affiliation, address and email, etc.) must upload in a different file named "Information about authors".

The self-citing should be restricted to the strictly necessary cases and, at the time of submission of the work, the author must report the existence of self-citing in order for it to be eliminated to avoid their identification by the peer review process.

It is suggested to the author to previously review the digital repository of articles published by the Journal, with the objective to identifying texts in the same subject matter, which may contribute to the construction of the state of the art of the issue.

EVALUATION PROCESS FOR ARTICLES AND TRANSLATIONS

The texts received in each call will receive three evaluations. The first evaluation will be by the Editor who, together with the Editorial Board or the Editorial Assistant, will determine the compliance with the minimum standards for submitting papers to the Journal.

The second evaluation or review is carried out by academic peers, preferably two (double-blind peer review). The general rule is that one of the pairs is national (from Colombia) and the other one is international. The peers are selected from scientific and academic index and databases. These evaluation reports will focus on scientific quality, structure, argumentation, use of bibliographical references, rigor in the handling of the subject, the category of writing according to Colciencias classification and respect for copyright and Ethical standards of the Journal.

The Editor, based on the concepts of the academic reviewers, and after informing the Editorial Board, will give one of the following three responses to the author: i) Rejected; li) Accepted with modifications; lii) Accepted without modifications. In all cases the author will be informed of the concept of the academic reviewers without giving details that allow the identification of the evaluators. The Editor will determine the dates of delivery of the corrected papers with a view to their formal and idiomatic evaluation.

Once the article has been accepted and delivered with the corrections indicated, the author agrees to its publication. The author should also guarantee the non-infringement of copyrights and expressly reiterate that the text is an unpublished material.

The third evaluation will be formal and idiomatic and will be done on those works that were approved by the academic peers and will be in charge of the Journal.

Only the articles elaborated rigorously according to the guidelines of this guide will be entered into the evaluation process.

EVALUATION PROCESS FOR REVIEWS

Reviews are assessed directly by the Editorial Board of the journal, they don't require peer review.

Likewise, if Editorial Board approved the review, it must accomplish all the editorial requirements before its publication.

ARTICLE PROCESSING CHARGE (APC)

Journal *Revista Filosofía UIS* will not demand to the Authors any fee for the publishing process of articles, reviews or translations. Likewise, the journal will not pay any royalty or fee to the Authors.

FORMAL STRUCTURE

- The texts must be typed in Word, with double spacing.
- The texts should be structured according to the grammar, spelling and syntax of the language in which they are presented. The Editorial Board may suggest stylistic and form corrections.
- Terms and expressions in a different language should be italicized.
- The title must be in accordance with the subject matter and must have a corresponding translation into Spanish and English.
- Submissions should include an analytical summary of approximately six (6) lines and five (5) keywords in the original language with their respective translation into English and Spanish.
- The summary of the articles should meet the characteristics of the analytical summary, since it must present the synthesis of concepts, approaches, proposals or ideas, according to the structural organization of the original text and highlighting its essential elements.
- The information of the author or authors cannot exceed three (3) lines and must include a brief biographical summary as follows: full name, nationality, most relevant academic training, institutional affiliation, academic position and electronic mail.
- The information in the text will be limited to its typology. However, if it is a scientific research article, the name of the group and project to which it is related must be indicated; as well as the status of the project (in progress, ended, etc.), funding institution and entity that supports the manuscript.
- The length of the articles should be between 5000 and 10000 words, and reviews must not be longer than 3000 words. The tables and images are not part of the extension of the text presented. Exceptional cases may be resolved by the Editorial Board.

- The publication of the article and its contents are entirely the responsibility of the author.

SYSTEM OF QUOTES AND BIBLIOGRAPHY

The system of citations and bibliographical references used in the journal *Revista Filosofía UIS* is the one presented by the American Psychology Association-APA- in its Manual "*APA Style Citation*". For more information, visit www.apastyle.org

Citation

APA standards recommend including citations in the text by using references in parentheses.

- Quotations: they will be made in the body of the text and must be enclosed in quotation marks as long as they do not exceed five (5) lines. The reference of this quotation is incorporated in parenthesis, according to the APA standards, which include the author's surname, the year of publication and the page (Surname, Year, Page). e.g. (Foucault, 2001, p.7), (Foucault, 2001, pp. 7-9). It is important to note that if you cite a specific idea or text, you must indicate the page or pages where they are.
- Textual citing of more than five (5) lines should be written in single line, single line spacing, centered alignment, with lower margins than the main text, without quotation marks, and with a smaller font.
- The above-mentioned guidelines will apply equally in the case of citations taken from the Internet.

REFERENCES

The list of references cites exclusively the sources cited in the article.

This section goes to the end of the text and preceded by the title **References**.

References for more than one work by the same author should ordered by date, starting with the oldest.

Note: when there is two Works by the same Author and the same year, it is necessary to include a letter, in alphabetical order, next to the year of publication.

Example:

Habermas, J. (2004a). *La lógica de las ciencias sociales*.

Habermas, J. (2004b). *Más allá del Estado Nacional*.

Printed material

Books

Surname and first letter of the author's name or names, followed by year of publication in parentheses. Title and subtitle of the book; these should be in italics and with initial capital letters. Edition and translator, if applicable. City of the edition and name of the publisher separated by colon.

Example:

Pérez, P. (1990). *Introducción a la psicología social*. 2^a ed. Trad. Juan Vélez. Barcelona: Planeta.

With editor:

Surname and first letter of the name (s), Name of the Editor (ed.) or (eds.). (Year). Title. City: Editorial.

Example:

Pérez, G. y Vélez, D. (eds.). (2004). *El legado de Immanuel Kant. Actualidad y perspectivas*. Bogotá: Norma.

Chapter of a book

Surname and first letter of the author's name or names and in brackets, year of publication. Title of the chapter, in quotation marks, followed by the preposition on, title of the book in italics, city of the edition and name of the Editor separated by colon.

Example:

Pérez, A. (1995). "Ciudad y desarrollo", en: Vélez, J. y Gil, A. (eds). *Esplendores urbanos del siglo XIX*. Bucaramanga: Universidad Industrial de Santander.

Serial publication (journal or newspapers)

Journal articles:

Surname and first letter of the author's name or names, year of publication in parentheses. Title of the article in quotation marks, journal name or publication title, issue(number), pages.

Example of Journal:

Pérez, K. (1997). La importancia de la religión en la visión futurista urbana. *Revista Iberoamericana de estudios urbanos*, volumen LXIII, (178-179), 129-140.

Newspaper articles:

Surname and first letter of author's name or names, year, month and day of publication, title of article in quotation marks. Title of the newspaper in italics, pages.

Newspaper Example:

López, C. (2016, mayo 10). Entrevista con Pedro Pérez sobre la transformación energética. *El Espectador*, 9-10.

Publications on the internet

The sources taken from the Internet should be related in a different section, after the references and subtitled **Cybergraphy**.

Surname and first letter of the author's name or names. Year of publication in parentheses. Title of the article in quotation marks. Taken from: "title of the publication in italics, issue (number), pp. Retrieved from: Specify URL or Digital Object Identifier (DOI).

Example:

Shu-Cheng, S. (2009). Are supervisors fair mediators? The effects of personality traits and age difference on expected mediation fairness. Tomado de: *Social Behavior and Personality*, volumen 37 (1), 59-118. Recuperado de: [http:// www.swetswise.com/titleBank/ getAtoZList.do?title=187408](http://www.swetswise.com/titleBank/getAtoZList.do?title=187408).
