

Revista Integración Declaration of ethic and good editorial practices

Revista Integración only accepts original and high quality articles both theoretical or applied, in all areas of mathematics. In exceptional cases, review articles are considered; the decisions of them are taking by the Editorial Board.

Revista Integración considers important to maintain high ethical standards in the publication of all its articles, that, it is necessary to take into account the necessary measures to prevent fraud, plagiarism, salami slicing and another kind of scientific misconduct.

Editorial Board, authors and referees must take into account the following considerations:

Responsibilities of authors

- Authors must declare that the paper has not been previously published and is not under consideration for publication anywhere else (except in the form of an abstract or as part of a published lecture or academic thesis or as a preprint). Moreover, authors must be aware that the paper does not violate any copyright or other proprietary rights of any person, university or institution.
- Authors must confirm, by signing the copyright assignment, according to the format established by **Revista Integración** that all authors agree to submit their article to evaluation under the editorial standards of the journal.
- Authors must declare if there is any potential conflict of interest that may affect the editorial process.
- When the authors use or base their results in previous works, they must mention, relate and cite properly the respective references. The authors must keep supports, data and its analysis, related to the submitted manuscript. When the Editor or the Editorial Board require this information (for duly justified reasons) the authors should facilitate the access to such data. Once it requested, the

information will enter in a chain of custody to ensure the confidentiality and protection of information by the journal.

- Authors must avoid manipulation or omission of research materials such as images, data or results. The submitted research must given accurately and according with the outcome of the study. Although image manipulation could be considered acceptable (e.g. improve image's quality), if an image is manipulated significantly the authors must communicate with the journal before submitting article, to ensure that this practice is permitted, and indicate improvements in the legend of the image.
- Authors should carefully review the final version of the article, following strictly the editorial standards of the journal, and report any errors to be corrected promptly before its publication. In the case of finding significant errors after the publication of an article, authors should promptly notify the Editor or Editorial Board and cooperate with the **Revista Integración** in the publication of an erratum, or in cases where deemed necessary, remove the article from the published number.

Responsibilities of Editorial Board

- The Editorial Board must act objectively throughout the review process and publication of the articles, without any sexual, religious, political or origin of the authors discrimination. Also, they must consider the acceptance of articles based on strictly academic and scientific quality criteria, regardless of any commercial, personal or institutional influence.
- The Editor, with the support of the Editorial Board, is responsible for deciding which articles received by the journal should be published. The Editorial Board should be guided by the editorial standards of the journal and must take into account the different legal aspects in force concerning copyright and bad scientific practices.
- The Editorial Board must accept and follow proper procedures to resolve any complaints or misunderstandings ethical or conflict of interest. They will act in accordance with the regulations, policies and procedures established by the

Universidad Industrial de Santander. In any case, the authors will have the opportunity to respond to potential conflict of interest. Any complaint must be supported with documentation to check improper conduct.

Responsibilities of the reviewers

- Referees are responsible to evaluate objectively the articles submitted, who voluntarily have agreed to review. Likewise, is expected collaboration with review times, in order to avoid delays in the evaluation process.
- Referees must maintain the confidentiality of the information contained in each paper.
- If a referee considers that the content of an article presents some fragmentation or similarity with other previously published articles, or in publishing process, they must notify the Editor or Editorial Board, in a timely manner.
- Referees must report any possible conflict of interest with an article either institutional, financial, collaboration or other between the referee and authors.
- Referees that after acceptance as such, not feel qualified to review an article or be aware that it will be impossible to meet the deadline required to make their evaluation, they must notify the Editor as soon as possible.

Confidentiality

Revista Integración seeks to ensure a fair and objective review of articles using peer review process. The Editor and the Editorial Board must not disclose any information about any paper that has been submitted to the journal for review. Only people who can exchange information are referees and members of the Editorial Board as long as necessary.

The evaluation process is confidential and it will not be possible to appeal the final results of the evaluation process in any case. The relevant decisions will be communicated to the authors, along with relevant comments.



Disclosure and conflict of interest

All articles published in **Revista Integración** are open access, that is, they can be freely read, downloaded, copied, distributed, printed, or cited. The opinions expressed in articles published are those of the authors and do not necessarily coincide with those of the Editorial Board or with the administration of the Escuela de Matemáticas at the Universidad Industrial de Santander.
